
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
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
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
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


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CHAPTER 10

PARTIAL PICK RUDIMENTS

The first group of Combination Rudiments that we will explore together are the Partial Pick Rudiments.

The Partial Pick Rudiments are a simple combination of picking and legato motions; you are partially picking the Rudiment, and the remainder is covered with Legato.

The specific Partial Pick Rudiments which have been included here are by far the most common that you will encounter in real music.

There are certainly many other possible ways of combining picking and legato, so feel free to look for others once you have these ones learned.
